



GILLIS PERFORMANCE RESTORATIONS

MCT Members: When we left off last month we were in the middle off adding stripes to the 1965 Fastback. We still had the hood, stone guard, grille panel and front valance to paint



(1) Brian finished taping and I sprayed the blue and later the clear on those parts.

(2) We also had to add hood pins. Shelby removed the hood bumpers on the radiator support and replaced them with hood pins.








(3) Everything has been wet sanded, buffed and lined up and the front grille installed.

(4) The owner wanted the trim painted black. ↑ You can paint the trim and chrome parts after sanding with 180 grit paper and spraying two coats of SPI black epoxy. The next day, I sprayed two coats of SPI Matte Black.

Marilu, is Customer Concierge with Beechcraft Textron Aviation and Papo, a Field Service Engineer with Smiths Detection. Papo is also the owner of PR Autobody & Collision Center, in Tampa.

As Papo tells it, "Ive been a 'gearhead' ever since I can remember, and have been in love with cars, no matter the manufacturer. My first car was a '66 Chevy Nova. I had the car for a couple years and traded it for a '73 MACH I with the Q code 351C and a 4 speed. That was the exact moment the Mustang madness began for me. Ever since, I have owned well over 15 Mustangs that have included a '70 BOSS, a '69 MACH I, a '66 GT Fastback, a '66 GT Coupe, a '66 Coupe, 3speed with bench seat, a '73 Convertible, a '92 GT Convertible, a '93 Cobra, a '93 GT Convertible, and an '85 GT T-top. 1st Annual Heritage Springs Car Show

A beautiful day in the 70's to celebrate Heritage Springs CC first, of hopefully many, annual car shows. Attending were MCT members Joe Jefferson, Phil & Joyce Bendishaw, Mark & Lerma Eastty, Joe Salerno & Harry DePeppe.







The 725HP Coyote V8 Galpin Fisker Mustang Rocket

Henrik Fisker and Galpin AutoSports pulled the covers off their super-Mustang creation, the Rocket. the first in a series of low production volume Mustangs set for production by GAS. The Rocket features a substantially reworked body with a new front end, hood, and wider fenders — all crafted from carbon fiber. Under the Rocket's hood lies theMustang GT's original 5.0-liter V-8 but with a Whipple supercharger forcing air down its throat. The spinning screws give the Coyote engine an impressive 725 horsepower. It's all routed through the 'Stang's six-speed manual gearbox. Fisker and the guys at GAS didn't stop there. The suspension is updated with fully adjustable shocks, enabling owners to dial in the style of performance they want. Large, 21-inch wheels are wrapped with Pirelli P-Zero rubber.

The Mustang Rocket is available though Galpin's Ford dealer network or select hand-picked Ford dealers around the world. While the company hasn't given any official word on pricing, the talk around the LA Auto Show floor put its sticker price just over the \$100,000 mark.
