



Gillis Restorations builds every car as if it were Rusty's own. They are a one stop restoration shop. From rust repairs to turn key restorations, no job is too big or too small. Let's see what Rusty is up to this month ...

Brian removed the outer cowl on the 1965 Mustang convertible before I took it to the sandblaster so it could be sandblasted. The lower cowl is still attached to help keep everything lined up and also so it can be sand blasted. (See picture #1)

We found a lot of rust holes in the floor once it came back from sandblasting and will replace with a one piece floor but Brian wanted to repair the cowl first. (See picture #2)

The outer cowl was sand blasted and will be reused. (See picture #3)

I epoxy primed both sides. (See picture #4)

The lower cowl was removed by drilling out a bunch of spot welds and did not find any ma-

jor rust. (See picture #5)

The back side of the lower cowl was stripped down to bare metal and as you can see is in very good shape now after Brian repaired it in my last report. (See picture #6)

I epoxy primed the back side first and the next day the top was epoxy primed. (See picture #7)

Brian removed the surface rust by grinding and sanding followed by brushing epoxy since it is hard to get a spray gun in there and you will never see it once everything is assembled. (See picture #8)

Lower cowl clamped in place ready for plug welding. (See picture #9)

Brian ground the welds and is ready to install the outer cowl. (See picture #10)

Brian is using a mig welder to fill in all the holes that he had to drill when he removed the cowl using plug welds. (See picture #11)



Outer cowl welded in place and plug welds ground down now ready to



The one piece floor was sanded on both sides and I already epoxy primed the other side. (See picture #13)

The next day I epoxy primed this side. (See picture #14)

Brian first had to drill out the spot welds on the one piece seat riser that attached to the floor and inner rockers. He is taking the floor apart a little at a time to give him a place to stand that while cutting out the floor. (See picture #15)

Floor pan removed. Brian still has to remove the remaining floor under the rocker panels. (See picture #16)




