MCT Caravan to this show— You are invited to join the MCT group to caravan to the show. This will also allow us to arrive and park together at the event. Our meeting/gathering point will be at a Burger King east of Tampa, I-4, Exit 14, McIntosh Rd. Just south of the exit ramp, Burger King is on the left. Drive time to the show should be under 30 minutes. Our planned departure time is 8 am. If you want to eat breakfast, please allow time prior to the 8 am departure.

<u>Important to know!</u> Carlisle is holding an open car show of their own on Saturday and Sunday separate from our Mustang and Ford powered show. Be sure to register for the Mustangs & Mustangs show if you want to be part of our show.

We are planning on a modified judged format this year. Only **pre-registered** cars 2018 and older will be judged. 2019 and 2020 and Day of Show registered cars will be Popular Vote. Remember, this show is designed to be fun.

Every show vehicle MUST have a working fire extinguisher!

Imperial Mustangs of Polk County will have a limited number of fire extinguishers for sale at the show. This show is on grass and although your car is safe what do you know about the car next to you.

Registration closes at 10:00 AM so you MUST arrive by then to guarantee a picture of your show vehicle with a P-51. No cars will be admitted after registration closes. You may be admitted as a pedestrian.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, FOR SALE SIGNS OR PETS ALLOWED AT THE SHOW.

The show will be held rain or shine. No refunds after February 10, 2020 or for late arrivals. For safety reasons we ask that you not leave the show with your car until after the award presentation finishes.
